CUSTOMER OWNED GENERATION

I SUBJECT:

Customer Owned Generation

II POLICY:

Sun River Electric Cooperative recognizes that members may want to take advantage of alternative on-site generation sources. To this end, Sun River adopts the Interconnection Guidelines as passed by the Montana Electric Cooperatives Association (MECA) on September 30, 2008. The MECA policy is considered an attachment to this policy and outlines the specific means and requirements for interconnection of on-site generation with Sun River's lines.

III AVAILABILITY AND REQUIREMENTS:

Sun River utilizes automated meter reading (AMR) which allows for one meter to read both forward and reverse current flow.

Net metered installations are subject to an annual true-up, on a date to be specified by Sun River Electric. The settle up dates are included in the interconnection agreement required to be signed by the member prior to acceptance into the co-generation program.
